There are 34 colleges and universities in Singapore for international students providing various courses across various disciplines, out of which 6 are public universities. Three of Singapore's universities are in the 2019 QS World University Rankings top 500. The highest-ranked is the National University of Singapore (NUS), which is placed at 11th. The next highest-ranked is the Nanyang Technological University, Singapore (NTU), which is placed at 12th
