# Center of Simulation Medicine and Innovation Technologies

**Center of Simulation Medicine and Innovation Technologies** or COSMIT is a recent creation of BSMU which provides the students with an opportunity to develop their practical skills while ensuring maximum safety for both patients and healthcare staff, it includes:

- **medical simulation rooms** (therapeutic room, surgical room, delivery room, gynaecological room, paediatric room, intensive care room, disaster medicine room, and medical procedures room)
- phantom classrooms
- computer classroom
- debriefing rooms.

The centre is equipped with high-technology simulation equipment, including robotic patients.

At COSMIT, the Indian students get the opportunity to hone their skills under close-to-real controlled conditions and work with simulated patients when studying subjects such as:

- internal medicine,
- surgery,
- paediatrics,
- obstetrics and gynaecology,
- anesthesiology and resuscitation medicine,
- emergency and disaster medicine,

- first aid, etc.

The honing of practical skills is carried out in specialised simulation rooms with a semi-transparent partition wall, using a simulator control panel and video recording of students' actions. Afterwards, the teacher and students go to the debriefing room, where they review and analyse the video recordings of the team's actions when "working the case", paying attention not only to the execution of medical techniques but also to communication and interaction among team members, the decision-making process, leadership role, tasks division, the inclusion of all team members, etc. Standardised patients are also involved for the training of the future physicians, which enables to simulate a close-to-real clinical situation and create direct contact and communication of students with real "patients".

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Where is BSMU located at?

**BSMU** is located in Chernivtsi in Western Ukraine. Chernivtsi is viewed as one of Western Ukraine's main cultural centres. The city is also considered one of Ukraine's important educational and architectural sites.

### Is there an airport near the university?

**BSMU** is located in Chernivtsi in Ukraine. There is an international airport in Chernivtsi.

### How to reach BSMU from Kyiv?

There is a direct flight from Kyiv to Chernivtsi. It takes about 1 hour to reach Chernivtsi from Kyiv via flight.

### How to travel from India to the BSMU, Ukraine?

From India, the student will take a direct flight from Delhi to Kyiv (approx. duration 6-8 hours). After this, there will be a connecting flight from Kyiv to Chernivtsi (approx. duration 1 hour).

## How far is the university hostel from the airport in Chernivtsi?

The hostel and the university is very close to the airport in Chernivtsi. It will take about 10-15 minutes via car or bus to reach the hostel from Chernivtsi International Airport.

## Fee Structure

The yearly fee of BSMU is US \$ 3,900 per year. BSMU is the cheapest & best option for MBBS in Ukraine for Indian students. Its per year tuition fee + hostel fee is lowest among all the medical universities in Ukraine. Also, it is the best as it has the highest FMGE passing percentage in Ukraine.

The total budget including tuition fees + hostel fees + Indian mess fee will be approx. Rs 25-26 lakh for 2020 session.

Note:

- USD 1 = Rs 70 used for calculation above. Kindly use the current exchange rate for calculating the fee.
- Tuition fee can be paid directly to the bank account of the university from the 1st year.
- Flight ticket charges extra.
- Tuition fee and hostel fee can be paid semester wise.
- Indian mess charges extra.
- Admission charges extra payable to JS Global.

The total budget including tuition fees + hostel fees + Indian mess will be approx. INR 25-26 lakh.

## Cheap and Best Medical University in Ukraine

Among all the medical universities in Ukraine, the university with the lowest overall budget (tuition fee + hostel fee + Mess) is Bukovinian State Medical University. The tuition fee of BSMU is USD 3,900 per year or approx. ₹2.80 lakh per year. The total budget is only about ₹26-27 lakh. On average, the tuition fee of the medical universities in Ukraine is between USD 4,500-5,000 which is more than that of BSMU. Budget wise, you will need between Rs 30-35 lakh in other universities. **BSMU is the cheapest university in Ukraine.** Compare MBBS in Ukraine Fees from cheapest to most expensive.

If you check the FMGE result of the medical universities in Ukraine between 2012-19, then the best overall passing percentage is from BSMU. Bukovinian is, in fact, the best medical university in Ukraine, Russia, Kyrgyzstan, Kazakhstan and Armenia. BSMU maintains a strict study environment for the students. In 2019, there were many students with 500+ marks in NEET who chose to take admission in this university.

Overall, the best study environment is in **BSMU and it is the answer to the question 'cheap and best' medical college in Ukraine.**
